12. How important is it to know the local language? Do you have proficiency in the local language?
13. How have you gone about making friends?

15. How do you keep in touch with family and friends from home?
16. Are you working? Is it difficult to find a job?
17. Are you an entrepreneur? Is it difficult to start a business?
18. Have you found that you have to live on less income? And if so how have you made the adjustment?

20. What are the opportunities to buy property?
21. What are the top 3 attractions or places of interest?
